インドの社会経済・人間開発に学ぶ: 南インドのケララ州を実例に

SOCIO-ECONOMIC AND HUMAN DEVELOPMENT STUDY OF INDIA: CASE STUDY OF KERALA MODEL

本プログラムは南インドを中心に、社会開発、経済開発、人間開発、環境問題といった 地域の抱える特徴や課題について考察します。また、現地の文化や社会についての理解だ けにとどまらず、就労見学などを通じて急成長を遂げているインドを学び、途上国と日本 との関わり方について理解を深めることを目指すものです。

研修は、多様性の国インドを様々な側面から理解するために、約1週間、南インドのケララ州にある現地協定校とのオンライン講義や学生交流に加えて、国内関連施設とのオンラインセッションを組み合わせて行ないます。最終日にはプログラムでの学びをまとめ、グループごとの最終発表を行います。

During the program, students will study intensively about the characteristics and issues of the region, especially in South India from various aspects.

In addition to understanding the local culture and society, students are expected to learn about India, which is growing rapidly, through site visits and discussions, and deepen our understanding of how they can relate with developing countries.

This one-week-program will consist of online lectures with local partner schools in Kerala and South India, student exchanges, and online sessions with related facilities in Japan.

Students will work in groups, and on the final day, they will summarize what they learned and make a final group presentation.
